Commissioner Bottom made a motion to have the Official County Newspaper for 2025 be The Grant Tribune-Sentinel, seconded by Commissioner Robertson, roll call vote, Robertson, yes, Tucker, yes, Bottom, yes, 3 ayes, motion carried.

Commissioner Bottom moved to declare surplus a computer stand from the Highway Superintendent Office. Commissioner Robertson seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

Commissioner Tucker shared the fair ground building projects. The Fair Board will attend a future meeting to give updates.

The Commissioners reviewed and interviewed the Applications for the Clerk position. Three applications were received. Interviews were conducted in open meeting.

Commissioner Bottom moved to appoint James (Jim) Brueggeman to complete the remaining term of the Perkins County Clerk, beginning February 1, 2025. Commissioner Robertson seconded the motion, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

9:30 a.m. Chairman Tucker opened the Public Hearing for Conditional Use for Midwest Electric Cooperative Corp.

Ed Dunn went over the findings and facts.

Public Comment – Manager Jayson Bishop from Midwest Electric Cooperative Corporation explained the purpose for doing the solar project. Dennis Demmel asked Jayson a few questions regarding this project.

Based on information contained in Finding of Fact Number CUP #13-24, and the recommendation of the Perkins County Planning Commission, it was moved by Commissioner Robertson and seconded by Commissioner Bottom to approve the Conditional Use Permit #13-24, submitted by Midwest Electric Cooperative Corporation, located in the SW corner of SW1/4 of section 29 township 11 range 38 West in Perkins County, Nebraska with the approval of the Midwest Electric Cooperative Corporation request and approved by the Zoning and Planning Board. Roll call vote, Robertson, yes, Tucker, yes, Bottom, yes, 3 ayes, motion carried.

The Board heard reports from Public Transit Director Trish Jimenez, Paramedic/EMT Travis Ogg, Highway/Noxious Weed Superintendent Steve Leimer, Assessor Peggy Burton, Treasurer Julie Sestak, County Clerk Rita Long and Sheriff Jim Brueggeman.

Public Transit Director Trish reported the need to purchase new software for the Public Transit. This is being mandated for drivers beginning July 2025. The mandate governs our funding to our Public Transit.

Highway Superintendent Steve Leimer gave his report. A rough draft was reviewed for waiver for unstuck vehicles.

Treasurer Julie Sestak submitted a transfer of funds. Commissioner Bottom moved to adopt Resolution 2025-2 to transfer funds to repay the Inheritance Fund by the Fair Fund that was advanced for \$15,000. Commissioner Robertson seconded, roll call vote, 3 ayes, Resolution Adopted.

County Clerk Rita Long gave some fun facts over the past 18 years she has work in the Clerk's office.
