County Attorney Richard Roberts provided an update to Commissioners on their request for a moratorium resolution on accepting applications for new energy systems and crypto mining operations.

New Business:

Commissioners discussed the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 NIRMA Deductibles and Insurance Renewal. No changes were made to deductibles for the upcoming fiscal year.

Highway Superintendent Steve Leimer discussed with Commissioners the need to have a secondary substance abuse professional agency for the Federal Department of Transportation Drug and Alcohol Testing Program. Commissioner Bottom moved to sign a professional services agreement with American Substance Abuse Professionals for the secondary services. Seconded by Commissioner Robertson, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

County Budget Preparer James Brueggeman provided information to Commissioners on Cost of Living Adjustment percentages for County Employees for Fiscal Year 2025-2026. Commissioner Bottom moved set the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Cost of Living Adjustment for County Employees at 2.3%. Commissioner Robertson seconded, roll call vote, 3 ayes, motion carried.

Business With Officials:

Sheriff Jeffrey Miller, A-EMT Travis Ogg, Highway/Noxious Weed Superintendent Steve Leimer and County Clerk James Brueggeman provided updates concerning their respective areas of county operations to the Commissioners. The Board acknowledged as received the May 2025 Fee Report, from the Perkins County Clerk/Register of Deeds.
