

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION PROCEEDING

APRIL 20, 2026

GRANT, NEBRASKA

The Board of Equalization meeting for Perkins County, Nebraska, was held at 9:00 a.m. at the County Courthouse in Grant, Nebraska.

Present: Commissioners Darin Robertson, Mark Bottom, and Steven Tucker; County Assessor Peggy Burton; County Attorney Richard Roberts; and County Clerk James Brueggeman.

Chairman Robertson called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. It was announced that notice of the meeting had been published in The Grant Tribune-Sentinel on April 16, 2026. The chairman also announced the location of the Open Meetings Act Poster in the Commissioner's Room. The agenda was reviewed. Commissioner Bottom moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Commissioner Tucker. A roll call vote was taken, with three ayes, and the motion carried. Commissioner Tucker moved to approve the minutes from the November 17, 2025, meeting, as published in The Grant Tribune-Sentinel, on Perkins County's website, and made available in the Clerk's Office. Commissioner Bottom seconded. Roll call vote: three ayes, and the motion carried.

County Assessor Peggy Burton presented Commissioners with tax list corrections 2026-01 for Ernest and Linda Chillemi, 2026-02 for Tommy Pankonin, and 2026-03 for Jerry and Deloris Jackson regarding 2022 Homestead Exemption adjustments issued by the Nebraska Property Tax Administrator. Commissioner Bottom moved to approve the corrections as presented. Commissioner Tucker seconded the motion. The roll call vote resulted in 3 ayes, and the motion passed.

Commissioner Tucker motioned to adjourn the Board of Equalization meeting, seconded by Commissioner Bottom; roll call vote: 3 ayes; motion carried.
