

BOARD OF EQUALIZATION PROCEEDING

JUNE 30, 2026

GRANT, NEBRASKA

The Board of Equalization meeting for Perkins County, Nebraska, took place at 9:00 a.m. at the County Courthouse in Grant, Nebraska.

Present: Commissioners Darin Robertson and Mark Bottom. Commissioner Steven Tucker is absent; County Assessor Regina Berry, County Attorney Richard Roberts, and County Clerk James Brueggeman.

Chairman Robertson called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. It was announced that notice of the meeting had been published in The Grant Tribune-Sentinel on June 25, 2026. The chairman also announced the location of the Open Meetings Act Poster in the Commissioner's Room. The agenda was reviewed. Commissioner Bottom moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Commissioner Robertson. A roll call vote was taken, with two ayes, Tucker absent, and the motion carried. Commissioner Bottom moved to approve the minutes from the May 18, 2026, meeting, as published in The Grant Tribune-Sentinel, on Perkins County's website, and made available in the Clerk's Office. Commissioner Robertson seconded. Roll call vote: two ayes, Tucker absent, and the motion carried.

County Assessor Regina Berry presented the 2026 Cemetery Report to the Commissioners, who acknowledged it as presented.

County Assessor Regina Berry presented tax list corrections 2026-05 for Wells Fargo Vendor Financial Services and 2026-06 for Joshua Grauerholz, both related to 2025 personal property taxes. Commissioner Bottom moved to approve the corrections as presented and have Chairman Robertson sign. Commissioner Robertson seconded the motion. The roll call vote resulted in 2 ayes, Tucker absent, and the motion passed.

Commissioner Bottom motioned to adjourn the Board of Equalization meeting, seconded by Commissioner Robertson; roll call vote: 2 ayes; Tucker absent, motion carried.
