The Perkins County, Nebraska, Board of Commissioners held its regular meeting at 8:34 a.m. in the County Courthouse in Grant, Nebraska.

Present: Commissioners Darin Robertson and Mark Bottom. Commissioner Steven Tucker is absent; County Attorney Richard Roberts, and County Clerk James Brueggeman.

Chairman Robertson called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. It was announced that notice of the meeting was published in The Grant Tribune-Sentinel on June 25, 2026. The chairman also announced the location of the Open Meetings Act Poster in the Commissioner's Room. The agenda was reviewed. Commissioner Bottom moved to approve the agenda, seconded by Commissioner Robertson. A roll call vote was taken, with two votes in favor; Tucker was absent, and the motion carried. Commissioner Bottom moved to approve the minutes from the June 15, 2026, meeting, as published in The Grant Tribune-Sentinel, on Perkins County's website, and made public in the Clerk's Office. Commissioner Robertson seconded. Roll call vote: two votes in favor; Tucker was absent, and the motion carried.

The payroll and claims submitted to the County Board were reviewed. Commissioner Bottom moved to approve the payroll and claims. Commissioner Robertson seconded. A roll call vote was taken, with two in favor, Tucker absent, and the motion was approved.

Business With Officials:

Commissioners received updates from County Clerk James Brueggeman, Sheriff Jeffrey Miller, Highway Superintendent Steve Leimer, and Assistant Highway Superintendent Brian Brassfield regarding their respective areas.

Board of Equalization:

Chairman Robertson recessed the meeting at 9:00 a.m to convene as the Perkins County Board of Equalization. Chairman Robertson reconvened the meeting at 9:10 a.m. after the Perkins County Board of Equalization meeting adjourned.

Unfinished Business:

There was no unfinished business.

New Business:

Commissioners reviewed informal bids for the purchase of semi tractors and compacting equipment for the Perkins County Roads Department. Commissioner Bottom moved to approve a bid from Bulldogger Services, Inc. for \$30,350 for a new 96" Finale Pass II Motor Grader Mounted Packer-Roller with pressure control valve and delivery. Commissioner Robertson seconded the motion. Roll call vote: two ayes, Tucker absent; motion carried. Commissioner Bottom then moved to approve a bid from Regier Truck Sales for two used 2022 Kenworth T680 semi tractors at \$49,900 each, with a trade-in of a county-owned 2015 Freightliner for \$31,500, totaling \$68,300. Commissioner Robertson seconded the motion. Roll call vote: two ayes, Tucker absent; motion carried.

Commissioners discussed a non-environmental Right of Entry Application with OmniTRAX related to a project on Elsie/Paxton Road on the southeast edge of Elsie. Commissioners and Highway Superintendent Leimer will gather additional information regarding the application process.

Commissioner Bottom made a motion to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Robertson. A roll call vote was then conducted, with both members present voting aye, Tucker absent, and the motion carried.

The meeting concluded at 9:21 a.m.
